2 Preparation

DANGER

Only use original accessories from BARTEC!

Only install radio module outside the potentially explosive atmosphere!

WARNING

Power off the tablet pc before installing the radio module and Micro SIM card, or the tablet computer might be damaged by the incorrect installation behaviors

Necessary equipment

- Radio module 4G/LTE
- Micro SIM card
- Battery
- Phillips head screwdriver

ESD measures

Take appropriate ESD measures to avoid damage to the device.

This includes working on an ESD mat. The operator must also be properly grounded.

3 Install radio module

- Switch off the Tablet PC.
- Remove the battery.
- Place the Tablet PC on the display. Ensure that no small parts lying around that could scratch the display.



Open the 4 screws of the cover.



 Prepare the radio module and the mini sim card. (Pictures as an example, real parts may vary)

Insert the sim card.



Install radio module.



 Insert the antenna cables into the socket on the radio module. Black cabel in the socket: MAIN Grey cabel in the socket: AUX

Agile S NI/Agile S Install radio module



Fix radio module with screw.



Put on the cover and tighten the 4 screws.

When closing the cover, make sure that the seal is not damaged.

4 Switch on the radio module

- Insert the battery.
- Switch on the Tablet PC.
- Open the Mobility Center by press the Home Button ^(G) located on the front panel or launching the Mobility Center using the icon on the desktop.
- If the WWAN feature is disabled (grey), tap on the WWAN icon to enable it (orange).

Status color of the WWAN symbol:

Symbol	Status Color	Erklärung
	orange	WWAN (3G/4G) is enabled.
LTE	grey	WWAN (3G/4G) is disabled.

You can check the wireless WWAN connection status through the wireless network connection status icon in the Windows notification area. The more bars encompassed, the better the signal is.



The further setup of the mobile phone settings is done via standard Microsoft Windows menus and settings.
